These measures cover various aspects of personal and property security during the spring season:

- 1. **Home Security Checks:** Ensure doors and windows are secure; consider installing security systems that can be monitored through an app on your phone and install outdoor lighting.
- Spring Cleaning Safety: Dispose of personal documents securely using a cross-cut shredder, keep valuables out of sight, and consider using a safe for essential items.
- 3. Yard Maintenance: Trim vegetation to maintain visibility and remove items that could be used to access your home.
- 4. **Travel Precautions:** Secure your home while away, ask a trusted individual to house-sit, and arrange mail delivery suspension.
- 5. Vehicle Safety: Lock car doors, close windows, and avoid leaving anything of value inside.
- 6. **Social Media Safety:** Be mindful of sharing travel plans or updates that could compromise home security.
- 7. **Community Engagement:** Participate in neighborhood watch programs and stay informed about local crime trends.
- 8. Child Safety: Educate children about danger and establish clear safety rules.
- 9. **Online Safety:** Exercise caution when interacting online and use secure websites for transactions.
- 10. **Reporting Suspicious Activity:** Report any suspicious individuals or activities to Irvine Police Department promptly by calling 949-724-7000 in an emergency call 911.
